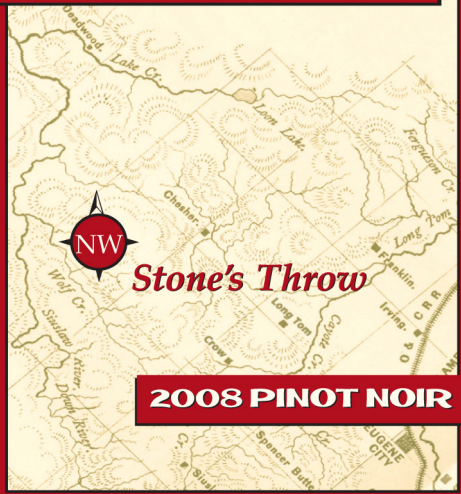

Pinot Noir

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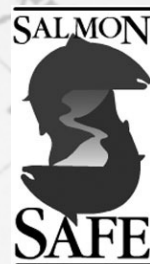


The glory of 2008 shines through in this delicious Pinot. A delicious attack with intense aromas of black cherry, spice and toast.

A positively vibrant and fully integrated mid-palate brings forth wave after wave of dark cherry, blackberry and plum flavors. Delightfully bracing acids and gripping tannins lend an engaging structure to the graceful finish.

Like its big brother, the Capital T Reserve, the Stone's Throw is not produced every year. It's last sighting was from the 2006 vintage

Specs: Dry. 13.4% Alcohol. 3.82 pH, 6.50 grams/liter TA at bottling. Sourced from Equinox Vineyard and Bellpine Vineyards. Pinot Noir clones Pommard, Wadenswil with Dijon selections 113 and 115. Harvested 9/28 through 10/3, 2008. 72 hour cold soak followed by small-lot fermentation in open-top vessels. 275 cases produced.



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
