Pinot Noir

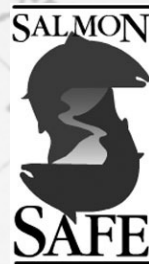

Specs: Dry. 12.6% Alcohol. 3.50 pH, 5.40 grams/liter TA at bottling. Sourced from Equinox Vineyard, Toad hall Vineyards and Belpine Vineyards. Pinot Noir clones Pommard, Wadenswil and Jackson with Dijon selections 113 and 115 Harvested 10/15 through 10/29, 2008. 72 hour cold soak followed by small-lot fermentation in open-top vessels.
